The children and families Barnardos helps are those who are living in poverty, who may be living in a home that is not the best environment for them or where they are neglected.



Barnardos helps over 26,000 children and their families each year.

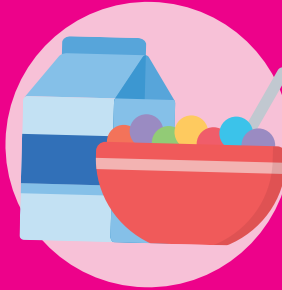


We have 54 service locations nationwide where we can be there to help local communities.

Barnardos works with children from 0-18 years of age in a lot of different ways. Here are just some of them:



We have **seven** centres we call Early Years Services around the country. Here we help children between the ages of 2 and 5 years of age to learn and develop, and to get them ready to start Big School.



In Barnardos' breakfast clubs we provide children with a warm and **nutritious breakfast** to help fill their tummies and set them up for the day.



Sometimes parents can struggle with taking care of their family so through what we call our **Family Support Services**, we help to equip parents with the skills to cope better and to provide the best, loving environment for their child to thrive in.



Our **After School Clubs** are run after children have finished their school day. We have book clubs to help with reading and we help children with their homework. We also run teamwork activities to help children make and keep friends as well as helping them cope with their emotions.

can provide two home visits to help a struggling parent to create the best home environment for their child to thrive

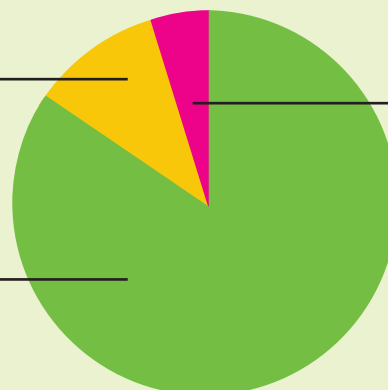
We know how important it is for you that the money you raise is spent wisely to help give children and their families a happier and brighter future. That's important to us too.
