Overview

This workshop is suitable for educators working within a School Age Childcare service interested in gaining more understanding about children's behaviour and the factors that impact on it.

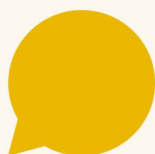
The aim of the workshop is to help educators to see beyond the child's behaviour and to introduce strategies for supporting children's behaviour using the Pyramid Model for Promoting Social-Emotional Competence in Infants and Children.



Outcomes

Following the training participants will be able to:

- Recognise all children's behaviour as communication and identify factors that influence different types of behaviour
- Describe the links between behaviours and emotions
- Explore the importance of nurturing and responsive relationships and supportive environments for all children
- List ways to help children to develop the skills to regulate their emotions and manage their own behaviour
